

Islamic Guidelines for

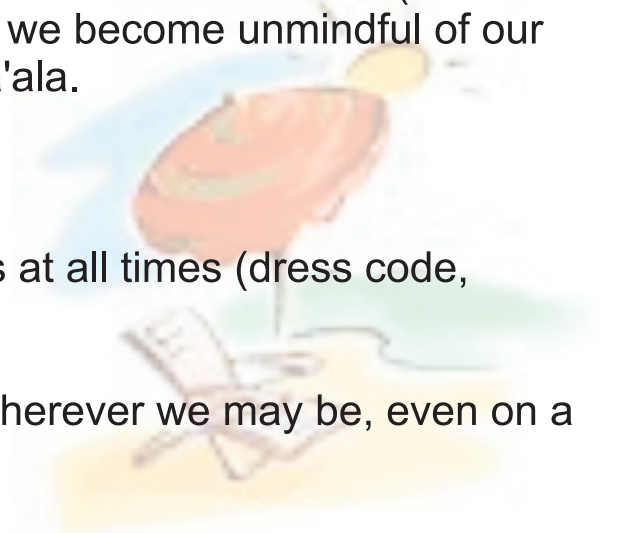
HOLIDAYS
