Religious Profiling Concern For Muslims

South Africans generally live in an environment of freedom of speech, religion and expression. This freedom is enjoyed by all who live in this land.

In a recent incident, two Muslim youths were subjected to religious profiling by a prominent food chain store in Durban North.

The youths, aged 15 and 18, were wearing the Muslim male dress or sowb as it is known, entered the store and observed themselves being followed by the store security. Three security guards followed the teenagers around the store as they shopped, before taking them aside once they joined the cashier queue.

They were then verbally abused by the security, who insulted them and drew comparisons to a recent armed robbery at the Gateway Mall shopping centre in Durban where the suspected criminals wore similar clothing as the boys. The two teenagers were embarrassed by this disgusting behaviour and reported the matter to store management, who subsequently apologised for the unruly behaviour of the security personnel.

Such acts of discrimination and religious profiling are unacceptable and against the constitution. South Africans enjoy diversity in faith, culture, traditions and practice of religion in our country. This right must be upheld, protected, and preserved at all times.

The behaviour of the security personnel is condemned strongly. No person should be disrespected, suspected, or profiled based on colour, religion, or ethnicity.

We also condemn in the strongest terms the use of Islamic apparel as a disguise by criminals at the recent robbery at the Gateway Mall, where a security guard was killed. A crime is a crime, irrespective of the dressing of the criminals. The dress code of the Muslim community should not be viewed with suspicion or disdain because of the acts of a few criminals.

German Masajid to broadcast Friday Jumu'ah Azan

GERMANY: Masajid in the German city of Cologne have been granted permission to broadcast the Azan over loudspeakers on Fridays.

The move comes after an agreement was struck between the city of Cologne and the Muslim community to ease restrictions.

All 35 mosques in Cologne will now be permitted to broadcast the call to prayer for up to five minutes on Fridays between noon and 3pm, under a two-year initiative.

That includes the Cologne Central Mosque, which was opened in 2018 after becoming a flashpoint for anti-Muslim sentiment from locals.

"Permitting the muazzin call is for me a sign of respect," Cologne Mayor Henriette Reker said.

"It shows that diversity is appreciated and lived in Cologne."

Cologne also allows its cathedral, and northern Europe's largest Gothic church, to sound bells in the city on a regular basis.

Masajid seeking to broadcast the Azan would have to comply with limits on the volume of their loudspeakers, and notify neighbours in advance.

An estimated 4.5 million Muslims live in Germany.

The reward of the Sunnah Salah

Hazrat Umm Habibah (RA) narrates that Nabi said, 'Whoever performs 12 Rakats of Salah in the day excluding the Fardh Salah, Allah will build a house in Jannah for him or a house in Jannah will be built for him.' (Sahih Muslim)

Some of the narrators of the chain of this Hadith in Sahih Muslim have said: 'I have continued performing these (12 Rakats) since I heard it (from my teacher).' This means these Sunnat Salah were never missed by the narrator the time he heard its virtue.

These 12 Rakats are Sunnah Muakkadah (emphasised Sunnah) and have been specified in the narration of Tirmizi Shareef as follows:

- 2 Rakats before Fajr
- 4 Rakats before Zuhr
- 2 Rakats after Zuhr
- 2 Rakats after Maghrib
- 2 Rakats after Isha(Sunan Tirmizi)

It is imperative that we perform these Sunnat Salah together with our Fardh Salah. Unfortunately, people tend to neglect these important Sunnah Salah by citing a lack of time, busy schedule or merely regarding them as 'not compulsory'. Surely we can spare a few minutes for the tremendous reward that has been promised for performing these Sunnah Salah.

May Allah Ta'ala make us all punctual and regular on our Salah and grant us the success and glad tidings thereof.

Title: At Tahirah - she was given this title because she did not follow or practice upon the customs and of Jahilivah even before(Nabi & commission as a) Prophethood.

Khadijah (RA) had the honour of being the very first person to accept Islam at the hands of Nabi & All Nabi's & children were born from her besides Ibrahim She passed away in Makkah Mukarramah approximately 3 years before Hijrah aged 65. She was married to Nabi 1 for 25 years and lies buried in Jannatul Mualla. (the cemetery of Makkah Mukarramah).

Virtues

Hazrat Abu Hurayrah 🎂 reported that Hazrat Jibreel 🕮 came to Nabi 🍇 and said, "O Nabi ! This is Khadijah RA. She has brought a vessel containing condiments and food. When she comes, convey greetings to her from her Creator and from me and give her the glad tidings of a house in Jannah of splendid pearls where there shall be no clamour and noise and no toil and labour." (Bukhari, Muslim)

Hazrat Ayesha (RA) said, "I was not envious of any of the wives of Nabi & as much as I was of Hazrat Khadijah (RA) although I did not see her. Nabi & remembered her often and mentioned her frequently. Sometimes he # would slaughter a sheep, slice it into pieces and send it to the friends of Hazrat Khadijah (RA) (out of appreciation). I would say, 'It is as if there is no other woman in this world besides Hazrat Khadijah (RA)'. Nabi # would respond, 'She was what she was and my children were born from her." (Bukhari)

I would like to know the ruling about 41 Yaseens and where did it originate from?

The recitation of Yaseen Shareef has many merits and benefits. In principle. there is no specified amount of recitation of this Surah mentioned in the Ouran and Hadith, Reciting a particular Surah a set number of times in certain instances may be established from the Ahadith. In other instances, this may be based on the experience of the pious elders and is similar to how a specific dosage of medication is prescribed. The experience of certain elders and pious scholars have given merit to the benefit of recitation of Surah Yaseen 41 times. However, this should not be regarded to be from the Sunnah or something compulsory.

What is the manner of making Dua at the graveside? Should the hands be raised or not and should one face the Oiblah or not?

Hafiz Ibn Hajar Asqalani (Rahimahullah) has mentioned in Fathul Baari, his commentary of Sahih Bukhari, the hadith of Hazrat Abdullah bin Masood (Radiyallahu Anhu) that he said, 'I saw the Messenger of Allah (Sallallahu Alayhi Wasallam) at the grave of Abdullah Zul Bajadain (Radiyallahu Anhu), when he completed burying him, the Prophet (Sallallahu Alayhi Wasallam) turned towards the Qiblah and raised his hands (for dua).

From the above Hadith, we can conclude that it is preferred to raise the hands when

making Dua at the grave. The hands should be raised whilst facing the Qiblah when this is convenient. This is generally the case when visiting the graveyard individually or with a small group of people.

When there is a large group for a Janazah and it is not practical and convenient for all the congregants to turn and face the Qiblah at once then raising the hands in Dua whilst not facing the Qiblah is permissible when there is no fear of doubt being created in the minds of the onlookers that people are praying to or asking the inmate of the grave. Alternately, one may also make Dua without raising the hands and without facing the Qiblah which is a better option when there is a large crowd.

If a Shari traveller misses Salah on a journey then when making up the missed Salah then should he make Qadha of the Salah as 2 Rakats or 4 Rakats?

Qadha Salah must be performed in the condition that it was missed. Hence, if a person missed Salah whilst travelling and he was still a traveller at the end of the Salah time then when making Qadha of the Fardh Salah of Zuhr, Asr and Isha he will perform 2 Rakats, not four even though he is performing the Salah at home.

What should I do with interest money?

Interest monies must be disposed off without the intention of any reward. It may be given to poor and deserving Muslims (i.e. recipients of Zakah) or to needy non-Muslim persons.

Darul Ihsan Fatwa Department kept busy by community

he Darul Ihsan Fatwa Department is continuing to make a difference within the community by fielding hundreds of gueries and issuing Islamic rulings on a monthly basis.

The department, which is based at the organisation's head office in Sea Cow Lake, is housed by Mufti Muhammad Mangera, Mufti Shafique Jakhura and Moulana Muhammad Ballim. Student learners are also in training in the department.

Hundreds of gueries are fielded monthly in person, telephonically and electronically, via e-mail and social media. Common issues dealt with at the Fatwa Department include business issues which require mediation. marriage disputes and inheritance matters. There is also an increased focus on queries according to the season, for example queries regarding fasting and Taraweeh during Ramadan and Ourbani and Haii during the month of Zul Hijjah.

However, business dealings appear to be the biggest problem area in the community.

Through their daily experiences, the Ulama from the Fatwa Department have this advice to the community:

"One of the major problems in our community is trust. Dishonesty, deception and failure to honour the contract is causing endless problems amongst friends and

families. On the assumption of trust, people do not document their deals and this leads to disappointment and heartbreak. It often results in major financial losses also. The golden Quranic rule is to have things in writing. Live like brothers and deal like strangers. Everything must be in black and white so you don't have issues."

The Fatwa Department disseminates educational material relating to general questions, social etiquette, guidance on Figh issues and biography of Sahabah (RA).

Services offered by the Darul Ihsan Fatwa Department are free of charge.

The department's primary focus is education and guidance. Education and knowledge is the key to success and peace in our lives.


Darul Ihsan brings water to South Coast family

Merits of Reconciliation

The following Qura'nic teachings emphasise upon Muslims the importance of reconciliation: "Verily the believers are brothers, so reconcile between your brothers." (Surah Hujarat - V 10)

"There is no good in most of their secret discussions (due to their sinful nature) except in him who enjoins charity, a good deed or reconciliation between people ..." (Surah Nisa - V 114)

"So, fear Allah and correct your mutual relations ..." (Surah Anfaal V.1)

When Muslim families, individuals or groups are locked in dispute, it is the responsibility of other Muslims to attempt to reconcile them. There is tremendous benefit and reward in bringing people together. When discord is allowed to fester, it leads to hatred, enmity and many other evils. This in turn leads to people becoming reactive and even violent.

When there is disunity among families, future generations 'inherit' the hatred caused by such discord and this enmity then passes on to the next generation.

Hazrat Abu Darda an arrates that Nabi asked the Sahabah and "Should I not inform you of an action that is superior to (Nafl) Salah, (Nafl) fasting and (Nafl) charity?" The Sahabah replied, "Surely, O Nabi ." Nabi replied, "Reconciling between two parties..." (Abu Dawood)

Note: Attempting to reconcile between two parties is considered to be superior to optional Salah, fasting and charity due to the exceptional benefits attributed to this action.

Let us work towards uniting people and avoid becoming a cause of discord and division.


